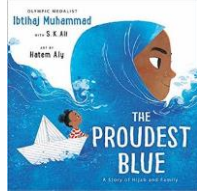
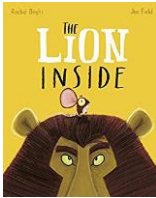
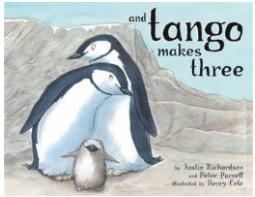


As Writers and Readers we will be using a number of books to:

As Scientists we will:

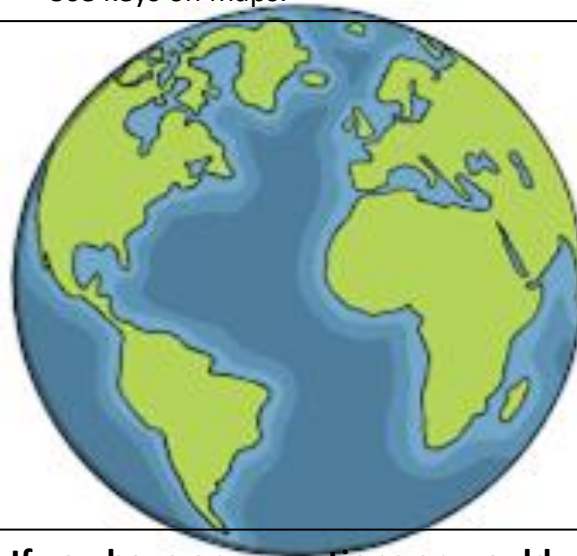
- Learn about animals habitats.
