Our five school rules are clear and simple. They are used consistently and are linked with consequences. They were created in conjunction with the children:

- 1. Treat everyone and everything with respect.

- 4. Walk quietly and on the left hand side of the corridor.
- 5. Always keep yourself and others safe.

At the beginning of each academic year teachers agree with pupils a set of class rules. These are displayed in the classroom to be used as a point of reference for maintaining high standards of behaviour for anyone working in that room; they are revised at the start of each half term.

## **Dining Hall Rules**

- Use an indoor voice.
- Remember to use your manners.
- Keep your table clean and pick up your rubbish.
- Return your tray carefully.
- Line-up sensibly when you have finished.

## **Playground Rules**

- Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- Talk respectfully to each other.
- Treat the equipment with respect.
- Listen to adults.
- Freeze after you hear the first bell, line up silently after you hear the second bell.
