- Compare the differences between the games we play now and the games that were played in the past.

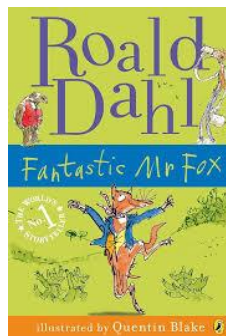
